

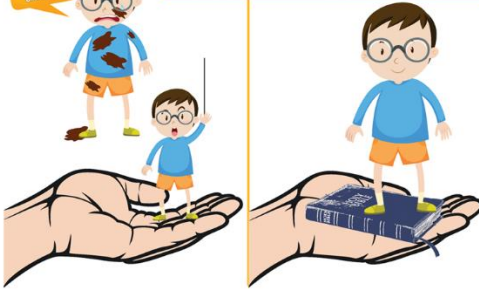


WEEK ONE REVIEW

 "For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved." - Romans 10:13



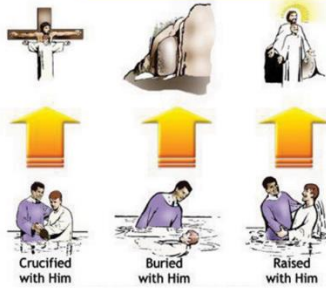
Everyone needs to be saved because everyone is born dirty and useless to God because of sin.

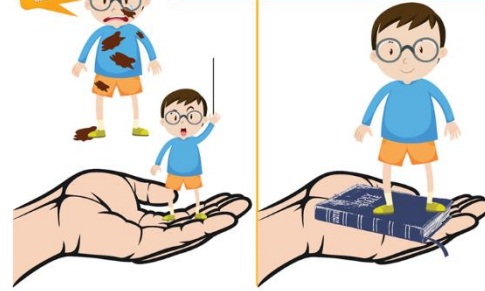

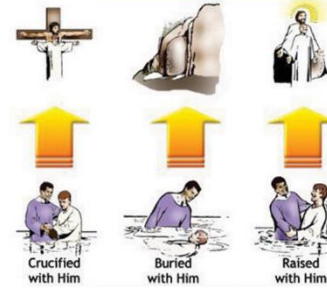
